Passes

All Parks Pass - Required at Elm Creek and Hyland, where snowmaking offers a reliable season of skiable snow. Valid at all Three Rivers parks offering cross-country skiing.

Natural Snow Parks Pass - Valid at all Three Rivers parks offering cross-country skiing, except Elm Creek and Hyland.

Passes are required for skiers ages 12+.
 Annual pass upgrades and daily exchanges available in person at the parks or administration center: daily exchanges also available online.

Minnesota ski passes are not required.

Elm Creek Ski Trails

Elm Creek offers short and simple trails for beginners and longer, more challenging trails for intermediate to advanced skiers. Of the 18.5K (11.5 miles) of ski trails, 5.5K (3.5 miles) are lighted for night skiing, with snowmaking on 2.5K (1.6 miles).

Elm Creek makes artificial snow on the Valley Trail (2.5K) for guaranteed skiing throughout the winter season; ski grooming is done on a daily basis.

Hours

Trails are open from 5 AM-10 PM. daily. Call for chalet hours.

Trail Information

- **Valley Trail** - Lighted trail with snowmaking; traditional and ski-skating.
- **Lake Trail** - Traditional and ski-skating.
- **Creek Trail** - Traditional and ski-skating.
- **Eagle Trail** - Traditional only.
- **Eastman Trail** - Traditional only.
- **Northern Lights** - Lighted trail; traditional and ski-skating. Can be accessed from shuttle parking lot with natural snow cover.

Rental equipment is not available during poor snow conditions.

For Your Safety

- Dogs and walking are not allowed on ski trails.
- Ski during park operating hours.
- Ski only on groomed trails and observe directional signs.
- Ski trails are one-way except where it's posted as a two-way.



Explore Elm Creek Park Reserve

At 4,900 acres, Elm Creek Park Reserve in Maple Grove, Champlin and Dayton is the largest park in Three Rivers Park District and offers numerous opportunities for recreation, exploration, relaxation and just plain fun.

- **Chalet** with cafe, stone fireplace, restrooms, guest services, ski patrol and equipment rental.
- **Eastman Nature Center** featuring interpretive programs, displays, snowshoe rentals, and 5 miles of snowshoe trails.
- **Tubing hill** near the chalet with snowmaking and lights. Call for fees and hours.
- **Downhill skiing and snowboarding** with snowmaking, lights and uphill lifts. Near the chalet. Rentals and lessons available.
- **Snowmobile trail** (10 miles) with parking in the north end of the park on County Road 121 or at the Chimpunk reservation picnic area using main entrance.
- **Multi-use trail** (4.3 miles) for skijoring, dog sledding, mountain biking, snowshoeing, hiking, and leashed dog walking. Trail is packed 1-2 times per week as needed. No permit required. Parking lot at County Road 121 (Fernbrook) and Elm Creek Road.
- **Sledding hill** located near summer swimming pond. No fee.
- **Singletrack trail** (12.7 miles) for mountain biking and hiking. Parking is off of Hayden Lake Road. This is only the beginning! Visit throughout the year to experience and explore recreation and nature. ThreeRiversParks.org

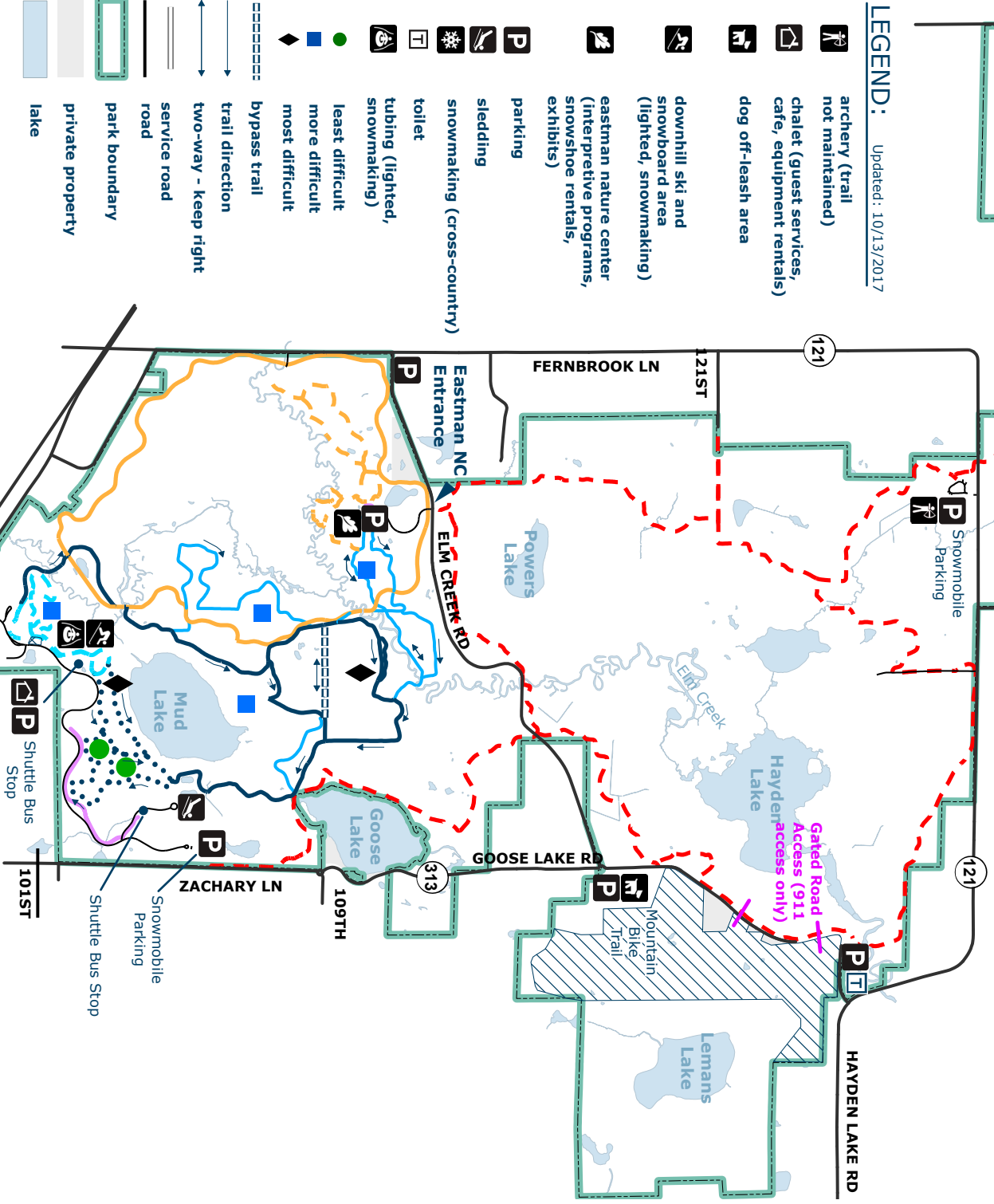
